Bishop Dr. Shaun McKinley serves as executive director of Global Communications for the Church of God of Prophecy International Offices, where he previously held roles as international director of Children's Ministries and Administrative Liaison to the Presiding Bishop. He has over 30 years of ministry experience and has trained leaders in more than 60 nations.

Shaun holds a Ph.D. in Leadership Studies (University of the Cumberland), an MBA in Marketing, and a B.S. in Public Relations. He is an adjunct instructor at five universities and was honored with Belhaven University's Faculty Excellence Award in 2019. In 2024, he was appointed to the board of the University of Tennessee's Center for Education and Lifelong Learning.

Ordained as bishop in 2018, Shaun is secretary and former three-term president of the Historical Society of Church of God Movements and has served on the International Assembly Task Force for 19 years. He currently serves as executive pastor and preschool teacher at Peerless Road Church. Shaun and his wife Stephanie have three daughters: Reagan, Madison, and Kennedy.

Bishop Dr. Timothy Harper



Bishop Dr. Tim Harper is currently the Regional Bishop for the Church of God of Prophecy for the Great Lakes Ministries (Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin). Tim is a dedicated husband and father. He and his wife Karen were married October 18, 1985. They have three children, Brittany, Chandler, and Stetson. Stetson and his wife, Miranda are blessed with two beautiful children, Grace Willow and Judah James.

Dr. Harper has extensive educational achievements. He has three master's degrees and has earned a DMin in Transformational Leadership from Ashland Theological Seminary and a PhD in World Religions from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. As a life-long learner, Dr. Harper engaged in post-doctoral studies at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Islamic Studies and Arabic.

Dr. Harper began his ministry in 1981. He has served as Kentucky State Youth Director and has served congregations in Kentucky and Michigan as Lead Pastor. Since 2004, Dr. Harper has served as the Regional Bishop of the Great Lakes Ministries of the Church of God of Prophecy (Indiana and Michigan, 2004–2008; Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, and Wisconsin, 2008 to present). As a mental health professional, Dr. Harper was in private practice as a licensed psychotherapist for five (5) years at a counseling agency in Dearborn, Michigan. He is also a nationally certified Healthy Congregations facilitator. He has been a guest speaker in conferences throughout North America and internationally.

Dr. Harper is a part-time professor at Lee University having taught courses in both the Old and New Testaments, Pastoral Studies including Counseling, Christian Family, Preaching, and Pastoral Ministry. He is also a part-time professor at the CGP Spirit and Life Seminary teaching theology, Christian church history and the history of the Church of God of Prophecy, and biblical studies. He is the author of several published articles on Counseling, Family ministry, Leadership dynamics, and Islamic studies.

Each congregation's clerk/treasurer reports monthly to Alabama State Ministries. Local church clerk/treasurer please send reports to State Ministries mailing address or electronically at alcogop.org by the 15th of each month.

LICENSED MINISTERS/BISHOPS

All licensed ministers and bishops (senior pastors and non-senior pastors) are required to report and tithe ministry income monthly to Alabama State Ministries. Reports and tithe may be submitted through the minister's online portal or by mail to Alabama State Ministries mailing address.

LAY-MINISTERS

Lay-ministers report annually to Alabama State Ministries by January 31st. Annual lay-minister reports must be signed by senior pastor and mailed to State Ministries mailing address.

CHURCH OF GOD OF PROPHECY STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe in the Holy Trinity—one God, eternally existing in Three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We believe in one God, the Father, creator of heaven and earth, of all things seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father. All things were made through Him and for Him. He is true God and true man. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, and was born of the virgin Mary. He suffered, died, was buried, and on the third day He rose from the dead. He ascended to the right hand of the Father, and He will return to judge the living and the dead. His kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who eternally proceeds from the Father. He is Teacher, Comforter, Helper and Giver of spiritual gifts. Through Him the saving and sanctifying works of Jesus Christ are applied to the life of believers. He is the empowering Presence of God in the life of the Christian and the Church. The Father has sent His Son to baptize with the Holy Spirit. Speaking in tongues and bearing the fruit of the Spirit are New Testament signs of being filled with the Holy Spirit.

We believe that salvation is by grace through faith in the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ on the cross; and that He died in our place. The believer's sins are forgiven by the shedding of His blood. We believe that healing of mind, body, soul and spirit is available to the believer through the blood of Jesus Christ, and the power of the Holy Spirit. We believe in one baptism in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

We believe that the grace of God brings forgiveness and reconciliation to those who repent, as well as transformation in holiness, enabling them to live a Christ-like life. Sanctification is both a definite work of grace, and a lifelong process of change in the believer brought by the blood of Jesus, the Word of God and the enabling power of the Holy Spirit.

We believe in one holy, universal Church, composed of all true believers in Jesus Christ, offering fellowship and calling for service to men and women of all peoples, nations, cultures and languages. We believe in the spiritual and ultimate visible unity of the Church.

We believe that the Bible—both Old and New Testaments—is the inspired Word of God. The Bible is God's revelation of Himself and His will to humankind, sufficient for instruction in salvation and daily Christian living. The Bible is the Christian's rule of faith and practice.

We believe that God will ultimately reconcile all things in heaven and earth in Christ. Therefore, we look forward to new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.
